

Prepare fresh use solutions daily. Do not reuse solutions. Discard solutions when they become visibly soiled. For disinfection, thoroughly wet the surfaces to be treated. Surfaces must remain moist for at least 10 minutes to assure proper germicidal action.

This product may be used for cleaning and disinfecting hard, non-porous, inanimate environmental surfaces (glass, metal, glazed porcelain, linoleum, tile, smooth leather, vinyl, enameled and finished wood surfaces) on walls, floors, appliances and furnishings.
