PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

IRITANT: Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if absorbed through skin. May be fatal if inhaled. Do not breathe dust or spray mist. Irritating to nose and throat. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, protective clothing and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewer treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Source or Regional Office of the EPA.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS: STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT. Mix only with water. Use only in water. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contact with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible generation of toxic fumes.

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling.

Bathers should not enter the treated pool until the chlorine level has dropped to 3 ppm or less.

- (1) Adjust the water pH to 7.2 - 7.6 as determined by a test kit. Add pH UP or pH DOWN as required.
- (2) If pool is newly filled or has not been previously stabilized, add STABILIZER (cyanuric acid). Follow the directions for use on the label.
- (3) Place tablets in the skimmer basket or automatic chlorinator according to manufacturer's recommendations for automatic chlorinator. Tablets require water flow or agitation to dissolve. To prevent bleaching of vinyl pools, DO NOT put tablets directly into the pool.
- (4) Maintain a chlorine residual of 1.0 - 1.5 p.p.m. as determined by a test kit. Generally, this means TWO TABLETS PER WEEK per 10,000 gallons of pool water.

Please note tablets are acidic and tend to lower the alkalinity and pH of pool water. Periodic additions of ALKA PLUS and pH UP may be required.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in original container in locked storage area. Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry and well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

FIRST AID

<b>If swallowed:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Call a poison control center, or doctor immediately for treatment advice.</li> <li>• Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.</li> <li>• Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.</li> <li>• Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.</li> </ul>
<b>If in eyes:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.</li> <li>• Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes then continue rinsing eye.</li> <li>• Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.</li> </ul>
<b>If on skin or clothing:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Take off contaminated clothing.</li> <li>• Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.</li> <li>• Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.</li> </ul>
<b>If inhaled:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Move person to fresh air.</li> <li>• If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.</li> <li>• Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.</li> </ul>
<b>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.</li> <li>• Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.</li> </ul>
