**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.**

**CONDITIONED POOLS**

One capful holds approximately 1 oz. Every day, add 2 oz. of GRANULAR per 10,000 gallons of pool water. Disperse into deep end of the pool in early morning or late evening.  
Maintain a reading on test kit of 1.0 - 1.5 ppm of available chlorine.  
Keep pH between 7.2 and 7.6.  
Use pH UP or pH DOWN as required.

**SPA INITIAL START-UP**

1. Ensure there is sufficient water in the Spa/Hot Tub to circulate through the heating and filtering equipment. Turn on the filter system.
2. Balance pH between 7.2 and 7.6 using pH PLUS or pH MINUS.
3. Add 4 ounces of PREVENT II per 500 gallons to inhibit staining and scale formation.
4. Add 1 ounce of GRANULAR per 250 gallons or until water contains an available chlorine reading of 1.5 - 3.0 ppm.
5. Add SPA-SHOCK as instructed.

**SPA DAILY TREATMENT**

1. Add 1 ounce of GRANULAR per 250 gallons. Allow to circulate for 15 minutes.
2. If bathing load is heavier than usual or Spa/Hot Tub is used more frequently, add additional GRANULAR until reading is 1.5 - 3.0 ppm available chlorine.
3. Maintain pH between 7.2 - 7.6.
4. Add 4 ounces of SPA-SHOCK per 500 gallons to shock the water after use.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store in original container in locked storage area. Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry and well ventilated area away from heat or open flame.
