STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL USE

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucous membrane irritation. Measure against circulatory shock.

DIAGNOSIS

1. In freshly filled pools or pools where algae growth is observed, add 1 oz. per 50,000 gallons of water to pool.
2. If algae growth is observed, add 1 oz. and control those algae species which are still present. If visible algae are still present, clean the pool, and add 1 oz. per 50,000 gallons of water.
3. If the pool water is treated as in (1) or (2), add 1 oz. per 50,000 gallons of water every five to ten days of active ingredients. See service manual for details.
4. If the pool water is treated as in (1) or (2), add 1 oz. periodically to determine the actual amount per 50,000 gallons of water of active ingredient.

Effective against green algae (Ankistrodesmus, Chlorella, Scenedesmus, etc.) and blue-green algae (Cylindrocapsa, Microcystis, etc.).

NOTE: For maximum effectiveness, pump water if it can mix uniformly. Do not mix product with other chemicals normally used in swimming pools.

This product may be used in all swimming pools and chemicals normally used in swimming pools.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Do not reuse empty container.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse or dispose of in a sanitary landfill. **GENERAL**: Consult Federal, State, and local regulations.
