1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 54998-9."

b. Revise the text of the Statement of Practical Treatment in the following manner:

"Avoid contact with skin eye or clothing. If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Seek medical attention if irritation persists. If in Eyes: Flush eyes immediately with gentle, steady stream of water for 15 minute. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If Swallowed: Drink large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Get prompt medical attention or call the poison control center." (Note that the beginning parts of these instructions, "If on Skin" etc., should be capitalized or printed in larger or bolder type from the remaining text.)

c. Add the succeeding sentences to the Precautionary Statements: "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse."

3. For the activator "Energize" which is used in conjunction with the subject product to release bromine, please submit within 75 days of the date of this notice a product label and Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) describing the composition of the activator for our records. (A blank CSF form is enclosed.)

4. The active ingredient used in this product formulation is currently undergoing the process of reregistration. Therefore, if additional requirements are imposed on this chemical under the reregistration process, this product will also be required to comply with the Reregistration Eligibility Document (RED).

5. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

**BROM-AID**

BROM-AID is a solution of bromide salts which is activated by ENERGIZE.

Bromine is released by the regular addition of ENERGIZE into water containing BROM-AID.

BROM-AID alone has no disinfectant properties but requires the release of bromine. It is a two step process. Follow the ENERGIZE label.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labelling.

- Initial Treatment:
- 1) Turn on filtration system to circulate the water.
  - 2) Treat Spa/Hot Tub with Prevent II before the addition of ENERGIZE. Let water circulate for 30 minutes.
  - 3) Add 5 ounces of BROM-AID per 250 gallons of water directly into the water.
  - 4) Add ENERGIZE as directed.

**Weekly Treatment:**  
Add one ounce of BROM-AID per 250 gallons of water.  
Due to varying bathing loads and frequency of use, Spa/Hot Tub should be tested to maintain a bromine residual level of 2-3 PPM. Increase the addition of BROM-AID and ENERGIZE to maintain the residual level.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**
