The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

- To update the "first aid" statement in accordance with PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

- In the "Ingredient" statement delete the "s" on Active Ingredients.
- Place the signal word "CAUTION" underneath "Keep Out of Reach of Children".
- Add the succeeding sentences to the Precautionary Statements: "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse."

A stamped copy of the accepted labeling is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

Brom-Aid

BROM-AID is a solution of bromide salts which is activated by the addition of ENERGIZE. Bromine is released by the regular addition of ENERGIZE into the Spa/Hot Tub water containing BROM-AID.

BROM-AID alone has no disinfectant properties but requires ENERGIZE to release the bromine. It has a two step process. Follow the directions on the ENERGIZE label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Initial treatment:

1. Turn on the filtration system to circulate the water.
2. Treat Spa/Hot Tub with Prevent II before the addition of BROM-AID or ENERGIZE. Let water circulate for 30 minutes.
3. Add 5 ounces of BROM-AID per 250 gallons of water directly into the Spa/Hot Tub.
4. Add ENERGIZE as directed.

Weekly Treatment:

Add one ounce of BROM-AID per 250 gallons of water.

Due to varying bathing loads and frequency of use, Spa/Hot Tub water should be maintained a bromine residual level of 2-3 PPM. During heavy use, increase the addition of BROM-AID and ENERGIZE to maintain this level.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing.

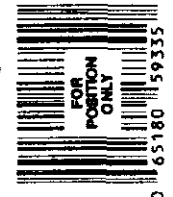
FIRST AID	
<i>If swallowed:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Call a poison control center, or doctor immediately for treatment advice. • Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. • Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. • Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
<i>If in eyes:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. • Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes then continue rinsing eye. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
<i>If on skin or clothing:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take off contaminated clothing. • Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
<i>If inhaled:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move person to fresh air. • If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. • Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
<i>NOTE TO PHYSICIAN</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in locked storage area. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
