PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

DANGER: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible generation of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reseal container. If possible, isolate container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water, if necessary.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Bathers should not enter the treated pool until the chlorine level has dropped to 3 ppm or less.

Premix the POOL SHOCK in a pail of water and pour the solution in the deep end of the pool. Discard the undissolved material in the bottom of the pail. Always add the chemical to water; never add water to the chemical. Add POOL SHOCK at the rate of 2 lbs. per 20,000 gallons of pool water. Treat pool with POOL SHOCK every two weeks during the heavy swimming pool periods.

For visible algae, treat pool with POOL SHOCK daily until algae is killed and turns brown. Vacuum dead algae from bottom of pool.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding this container. Do not reuse empty container but place in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning of equipment.
