The amended label referred to above, submitted to satisfy requirement #3 in the Registration Notice dated July 9, 2010 for Paladin Technical, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended, is acceptable with the following condition.

CONDITION

EPA has determined that the risk mitigation measures on the revised label for this product are necessary to adequately protect human health and the environment. Therefore, pursuant to 40 CFR § 152.130(d), EPA has decided that no product bearing previously approved labeling may be sold or distributed (released for shipment) by its registrant after December 1, 2012. Wherever state approval is required for sale or distribution of this product with this new labeling, EPA strongly encourages you to submit an application to the state authority as soon as possible. You should be aware that the Agency does not intend to modify the December 1, 2012 deadline because of any failure to obtain state approvals.

PALADIN Technical may only be used for repacking or formulation into end-use products intended for preplant fumigation of soil to control soil borne pests for the cultivation of the following fruiting vegetables: tomatoes, peppers, and eggplant; the following cucurbit crops: cucumbers, squash (all varieties), and melons (all varieties); the following small fruit crops: strawberries and blueberries; field grown ornamentals; and forest nursery crops. This product may also be used to formulate products for any additional use(s) not listed on this manufacturing use label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA submission requirements regarding support of such use(s). Manufacturer disclaims liability for claims or damages resulting from any use of a formulated product in a manner not listed on this label.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to mammals, birds, fish, and aquatic invertebrates. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

"Dimethyl Disulfide (DMDS) cannot be formulated into end-use products labeled for preplant or pretransplant uses unless the end-use registrant makes available to certified applicators who purchase or apply the end-use product a registrant developed training program approved by EPA.
