

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

One-Step is a proven cleaner-disinfectant-sanitizer. Fungicide-mildewstat-virucide in the presence of moderate amounts of organic soil.

Apply One-Step to walls, floors and other hard (non-porous) non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, sinks and bedframes with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device so as to thoroughly wet surfaces. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

Disinfection - to disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces. Use 2 oz. per gallon of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes.
