On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

 - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 55110-2".
 - b. The product name "Repell-All" is not acceptable. This name infers that this product is efficacious against all pests, which it is not. Please submit an acceptable product name.
 - c. This product is in toxicity category II and the signal word "Warning" must be used on the label as prominently as indicated in 40 CFR 156.10 (see attached copies). Use "Warning" both on the front label and at beginning of precautionary statement.
 - d. Change "Precaution" to "Precautionary".

- 2.e. Add under the Precautionary Statement Section the heading "Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals".
- f. Add to the beginning of this section "May cause eye injury. Harmful if swallowed."
- g. Although we still encourage inclusion, we have determined that it is acceptable to exclude the statement from your label, "If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you". You do not need to submit an amendment to remove this from your label.
- h. The "100% DEET" statement may be shown on the label, but it must be placed outside of the Active Ingredient Statement.
- i. The term "maximum protection" is not acceptable as indicated in 156.10(a)(5). We have accepted the term "maximum strength" and will allow that replacement if you so choose.
- j. Move the ~~the~~ "Disposal" statement on the blister card away from the Statement of Practical Treatment section.
3. Submit one (1) copy of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
