WHEAT & BARLEY, Bacterial leaf blight (*Pseudomonas syringae*), Bacterial leaf blight (*pseudomonas syringae*), Bacterial leaf streak (*Xanthomonas translucens*), Common Bunt (*Tilletia caries*), Apply BLUE COPPER SD at the rate of 4 ounces of formulated product per 100 pounds of seed.
