If a substance is sparingly soluble, its solubility may be reported in other terms such as ppm (ng/kg).

A determination of the dissociation constant for the pure grade of the active ingredient.

A determination of the pH of the technical product diluted or dispersed in distilled water. The determination shall be made at 20 degrees Celsius or 25 degrees Celsius as described in the section 63-12 of the Pesticide Assessment Guideline Subdivision 2.

c. Label Requirements

The warranty statement must not be located in the storage and disposal block.

The misuse statement must be located under the Directions for Use section. Remove this statement from the precautionary block.

2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

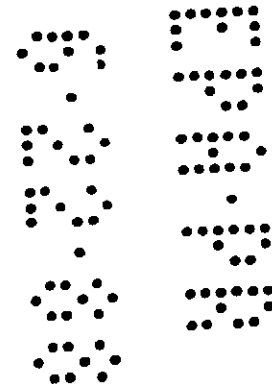
