- in the subsection "IF SWALLOWED" add the phrase "by mouth" after "Do not give anything"
- · in the Note to physician statement, change "if" to "of"
- 2. PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS block: in the first two lines, change the word "is" to "if"
- 3. PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT block:
 - · in line 3, change "resistant" to "resistance"
 - in line 6, add the phrase "made of any waterproof material" after the phrase "resistant gloves"
 - in ¶2, line 3, add the phrase "made of any waterproof material" after the phrase "resistant gloves"
- 4. WARANTEE STATEMENT: in the second paragraph change "MERCHANABILITY" to "MERCHANTABILITY"; change "ANYOTHER" to "ANY OTHER"

Products formulated with this product require registration with the United States Environmental Protection Agency. The formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining their own EPA registrations. This product is for use by commercial pesticide formulators for reformulation or repackaging use only.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store above -10°C.
