e. Under STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT, remove "Note to Physician" statement and place it immediately following the STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT. The "Note to Physician" statement must be clearly distinguished from the other statements.

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label before you release your product for shipment.
