This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

BLACK JACK LIQUID - 10 is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and innumerable effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using BLACK JACK LIQUID - 10

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial fluid ounces of BLACK JACK LIQUID - 10 per 10,000 gallons of water. To remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a pool add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces of BLACK JACK LIQUID - 10 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 13 fluid ounces of BLACK JACK LIQUID - 10 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains require an initial dose of 8 to 12 fluid ounces of BLACK JACK LIQUID - 10 per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 4 fluid ounces of BLACK JACK LIQUID - 10 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 to 3 fluid ounces of BLACK JACK LIQUID - 10 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

BLACK JACK LIQUID - 10 is compatible with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those used to treat pools and spas and is effective at BLACK JACK LIQUID - 10. However, do not mix BLACK JACK LIQUID - 10 with liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of the home and away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap
