Shield. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

c. Add the following additional statements to the first aid statement. The statements must be listed in order of toxicity, i.e. If swallowed; If on skin; If inhaled and If in eyes:

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

d. **IF IN EYES:** Hold eyelids open and flush with steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

The following statement must appear separate from, but in close proximity to the first aid statement:

"Note to Physician (doctor): Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."

- 3. The storage and disposal statement are not adequate for this type of product. Refer to PR notices 83-3 and 84-1 for guidance and appropriate "Storage and Disposal Statement.
- 4. For containers larger than one gallon, the appropriate environmental hazard statement must be added to the label under the heading "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS."
- 5. Refer to EPA letter dated June 18, 1999, section I with respect to the confidential statement of formula (CSF) and label claim for active ingredient. The CSF and label active ingredient percentage must be in agreement. Either revise the CSF or label so that their are in agreement.
- 6. Submit three copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

CHILD RESISTANT CAP INSTRUCTIONS: To Open, squeeze cap sides at flat spots as indicated by arrows and turn counter clockwise. Unscrew and remove cap. To Close, screw protective cap tightly after using.

General Cleaning: Remove cap, Squeeze gently, directing bowl cleaner under rim and on sides of bowl. Brush clean and flush toilet. Replace cap. Rinse brush with clean water.

To Disinfect Bowls: Remove water from the bowl. Squeeze gently 1 oz. of bowl cleaner onto bowl brush. Clean entire unit, especially under rim at water outlets. Allow to remain 10 minutes. Flush and rinse out bowl with clean water. A preliminary cleaning is necessary for the removal of heavy soil prior to disinfection.
