- c) Add the following statement of practical treatment to the label:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

If in eyes - Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.
 If swallowed - Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by tickling back of throat. Get medical attention.
 Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

- d) Add the following storage and disposal statements.

Storage: Store away from heat or flame in an area inaccessible to children.


Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash.

- e) The statement "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" must appear directly after the term "Directions For Use ."
- f) Delete the word "Caution" from the flammability hazard.
- g) The statement "Avoid contact with plastic, rayon, furniture finishes, and painted surfaces "should appear with the directions for use.
- h) The registration number which has been assigned to this product must be appear on the label as EPA Reg. No. 55205-1.
- i) Delete the word "Incredibly" from the statement "Incredibly effective xx protection."
- j) Submit storage stability data on this product. The product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero during a year of storage.

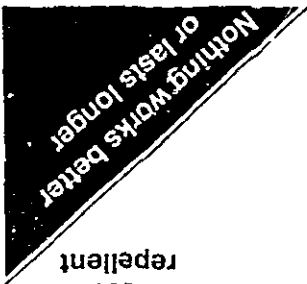
