The proposed amended label submitted on March 15, 2010, is accepted under the provisions of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, with the stipulation that the changes listed below must be made to that label.

- In item "1)" under "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" (page 2), delete "only" from the phrase "This product may only be used ... for:". As a second category of possible uses has been added, retaining "only" would be inconsistent with the rest of the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" section.
- In item "2)" under "DIRECTIONS FOR USE", insert "also" between "product" and "may".
- In the "CONTAINER DISPOSAL:" paragraph in the "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" box, replace "application equipment or a" with "the" in the sentence immediately following "Triple rinse as follows:". In the sentence "Empty the rinsate ... disposal", replace "application equipment or a" with "the" and delete "use or". This is a manufacturing-use product. There is no label-consistent use for the rinsate produced through cleaning containers. Loading rinsate into application equipment would violate the requirements indicated by the label phrase "For Formulator Use Only" and the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" section. As amended by this paragraph, the container-rinsing directions are appropriate for this product in rigid, nonrefillable containers with capacities greater than 5 gallons.

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4. The "TERMS" paragraph must be amended by adding "To the extent consistent with applicable laws," as an introductory phrase to the first sentence (i.e., before "Seller's).

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Submit two copies of final printed labeling before releasing this product for shipment under the labeling accepted via this letter.

If these conditions are not complied with, this registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e).
