The proposed amended label submitted on April 14, 2010, is accepted under the provisions of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, with the stipulation that the change noted below must be made to that label.

The "**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:**" paragraph in the "**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**" box does not indicate what is to be done for ultimate disposal in the event that recycling is not available. To fix this problem, add the sentence shown below to the end of the "**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:**" paragraph.

If recycling is not available, puncture container and dispose of it in a sanitary landfill or by other approved State and local procedures.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Submit two copies of final printed labeling before releasing this product for shipment under the labeling accepted via this letter.

If these conditions are not complied with, this registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e).

  - Mosquito larvae control: in swamps, marshes, floodwater areas, drainage areas, waste treatment, settling ponds, ditches, and other manmade depressions.
- 2) This product may also be used to formulate products for any additional use(s) not listed on the manufacturing-use product label if the formulator, user group or grower has complied with U.S. EPA submission requirements regarding support of such uses(s).

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
