- b. Under the heading Storage and Disposal, the following language must be used:

BUG MASTER is also a grooming aid and coat conditioner.

BUG MASTER kills and repels Stable Flies, Horn Flies, House Flies, Face Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Ticks, Fleas, and Lice.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

BUG MASTER has been especially developed for use on animals. It provides a protective hair coating against flies while imparting a high sheen to the hair when brushed out. Use one to two ounces per head per day, gives adequate protection. Apply by either a soft cloth or a fine mist spray.

**USE AS A SPRAY:**

BUG MASTER may be applied as a fine mist spray to stable area and around stable area and around stables for fast paralysis and kill of flies. Do not wet animals skin, or exceed two ounces per application. To control blood-sucking lice, apply to the infested areas of the animal, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair.

**USE AS A WIPE ON:**

First, brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Moisten (but do not wet to the point of dripping) a soft cloth and rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Pay special attention to the legs, shoulders, shanks, neck and facial areas where flies most often are seen. Only a light application is required. Avoid using an excessive amount on your animal. Do not wet skin. After application, brush out thoroughly to bring out bright sheen on the coat.
