The amendments referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section $s(z)(7)(\Lambda)$ of the Federal Insectic de. Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable subject to the following comments.

- 1. The terms ACTIV. INCREDIENTS and INERT INCREDIENTS should be in the same type size, be aligned to the same margin, and be equally prominent.
 - 2. The following statement should be added to PIPERONYL ECTOXIDE as a footnote to the impredient statement:

Equivalent to 0.40% (butylcarbityl) (6-propylpiperchyl)ether and 0.10% related compounds.

3. Submit data confirming that the sodium lauryl sulfate in your product does not contain formaldehyde. Your supplier may contact us directly referencing your EPA Registration Number in their response.
