Dear Mr. Volger:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(B), is conditionally accepted provided that:

1. The following revisions are made to the label: Revise the section IMPORTANT READ BEFORE USE on page 2 as follows:
 - a. In the paragraph following CONDITIONS, change "All such risks shall be assumed . ." to "To the extent consistent with applicable law, all such risks shall be assumed . . .".
 - b. In the paragraph following DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES, change "AGRIPHAR DISCLAIMS ANY LIABILITY WHATSOEVER . ." to "TO THE EXTENT CONSISTENT WITH APPLICABLE LAW, AGRIPHAR DISCLAIMS ANY LIABILITY WHATSOEVER . .".
 - c. In the paragraph LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY, change "THE EXCLUSIVE REMEDY OF THE USER . ." to "TO THE EXTENT CONSISTENT WITH APPLICABLE LAW, THE EXCLUSIVE REMEDY OF THE USER . .".
2. The following data are required as to support the registration of the uses on bananas and peanuts.
 - a. An impregnated diaper migration study. Due by: December 2009
 - b. Revise the residue analytical method, METH1595.02 to remove the conversion of residue results to "dodine free base" (this calculation is made at the step in which standard solutions are prepared). Residue results must be calculated in terms of dodine, as N-dodecylguanidine acetate in order to correspond to the tolerance expression. In addition, the typographical error in step 9.3.7 of the method should be corrected ["Repeat steps 9.2.33 to 9.2.6 two more times" should be changed to "Repeat steps 9.2.3 to 9.2.6 two more times"]. FIRST AID
