- 3. The section **HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS** must be revised to read as follows:

“Danger. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Causes skin burns. May be fatal if inhaled. Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Do not breathe dust. Avoid contact with skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.”

- 4. Change the section **PESTICIDE HANDLERS** to read:

“**PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT:** During mixing/loading or formulating of the concentrate, pesticide handlers must wear a coveralls over long-sleeved shirt and long pants, chemical resistant shoes, socks, goggles or face shield, chemical resistant gloves and a chemical resistant apron.”

- 5. Add the following box below the section **PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT:**

USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

- User should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.
- User should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then was thoroughly and put on clean clothing.
