DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding this container. Do not reuse empty container, but place in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning of equipment.

FARM AND HOME WELLS

1. Shock treat the well to a chlorine residual level of 5 ppm (parts per million) by dropping pellets directly into the well water.
2. Adjust chlorinator pellet feed rate or hand feed to retain a chlorine residual of 0.6 to 0.9 ppm.
3. Use test kit provided with chlorinator or purchased from your PELLE-CHLOR Pellets dealer to determine your chlorine residual.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDOUS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER:

Highly Corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or safety glasses and rubber gloves when handling this product. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

FIRST AID:
