

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

60-12 is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and minimum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using \_\_\_\_\_.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial fluid ounces of 60-12 per \_\_\_\_\_ to move settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a pool add initially 39 to 71 fluid ounces of \_\_\_\_\_ per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of \_\_\_\_\_ of 60-12 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains require an initial dose of 7 to 11 fluid ounces of \_\_\_\_\_ per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 4 fluid ounces of 60-12 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2 to 3 fluid ounces of 60-12 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment. 60-12 is compatible with \_\_\_\_\_ used to treat pools and spas and is effective at \_\_\_\_\_ 60-12 can be used in conjunction with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine required. However, do not mix 60-12 with other liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and away from food.
