DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this pesticide in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

APT-BIO 1 is used in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems must be cleaned to remove algal growth and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 5.1 APT-BIO 1 per 1000 gallons is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is effected. Subsequent slug additions of 1.7 APT-BIO 1 per 1000 gallons every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of additions should be made in the sump of water.

This product contains 1.03 lb. of active ingredients per gallon and weighs 8.88 lb. per gallon.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
