IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

- c. Use the following Agency prescribed wording in the Precautionary Statements:

- d. Under Storage and Disposal, correct the spelling of "stow" to "store".

- e. Under Environmental Hazards, change the first sentence to "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."

3. The Confidential Statement of Formula needs some minor changes. Submit a revised CSF for the record with percent by weight numbers in the blocks under 13b instead of "same" and for each trace amount impurity in the technical sulfur, enter an upper limit. In block 15-Purpose in Formulation write "impurity" for each impurity since inert ingredient (I.I.) implies an intentionally added ingredient.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
