
This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

CAUTION

GENERAL INFO

This product is a powdered insecticide grain: Wheat, Corn, Oats, Rye, Barley, and Sorghum. Protection is provided against Corn Weevil, Granary Weevil, Saw-Toothed Lesser Grain Borer, and Indian Meal Moth. Apply as directed with the grain for malathion. Treated grain is safe for feeding and can be milled into flour by normal production methods.

DIRECTIONS

FOR USE ON STORED GRAINS:
Apply this product to the grain at the rate of 5 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. of bin as the grain is being loaded or transferred.

To protect stored grains from attack by insects, apply this product to the surface of grain at the rate of 5 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. Apply the dust evenly over the surface immediately after grain is loaded into the bin. If necessary, reapply.

HOW TO

Apply this product when grain is in the bin. To determine the amount of product to apply, multiply the length by width by depth of the bin and divide this total by 0.8 to get the number of bags. Spread the correct amount of the product evenly over the surface of the grain. Cut into the grain with a pitchfork or similar tool. Mix the product with grain as it is dumped into the hopper. Further mixing will be aided by the grain falling and blowing into the bin. The product coating and grain roll down the bin.
