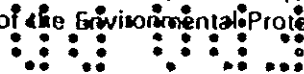

in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, minimum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to use.

For pools having just visible algae growth add Laten 3523 fluid ounces of Laten 3523 per 10,000 gallons of water. move settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of pool add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Laten 3523 per 10,000 gallons should be made every 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains require an initial dose of 8 to 12 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially Laten 3523 per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially Laten 3523 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Laten 3523 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.
