Inert Ingredients15%
Total	100.00%

- g. Include on the front panel the net weight of contents. (Refer to 162.10(d)).
- h. Zinc is active as a "fungistat" rather than as a "fungicide." The label claims "Killer" and "Kills" must be deleted. These claims should read, "Moss inhibitor" and "Inhibits growth of moss and fungi."

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

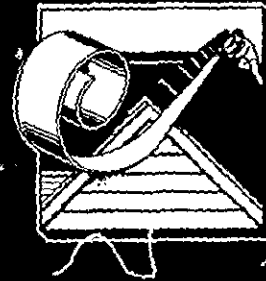
