

In areas of severe moss/fungus growth, a second coat of Z-STOP application may be necessary to assure its effectiveness over the entire roof surface.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply Z-STOP along each side of ridge cap along all roof peaks.
Apply below anything that blocks rain water flow, like chimneys, gables, vents, pipes, skylights.
Nail approximately every foot at high points with Z-STOP NAILS.
On roofs with moss or fungus, the existing growth must first be removed by pressure washing or brushing, then treated with a chemical to kill the root systems. Then install Z-STOP to keep it from growing back.
