The purpose of these submissions is to revise your labeling in accordance with our

previous letter.

Label review

We last approved labeling for this product about four (4) years ago, January 3, 2000. The labeling (can label, clamshell insert, and two holster cards) submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship your product.

A. Can Label

- 1. Make the change requested under "A,B,4" in our August 5, 2002, letter.
- 2. Add a blank line between the following text and the previous line ("may ... this product" to highlight this critical text to users:

This product has a range of up to 30 feet (9 meters). The canister empties in approximately 7 seconds.

- 3. Use Enclosure 1 to revise your "First Aid" text. See PR Notice 2001-1, which is available on the EPA website (www.epa.gov/pesticides), for additional information.
- 4. Use Enclosure 2 to revise your "Storage and Disposal" text. See PR Notice 2001-6, which is available on the EPA website (www.epa.gov/pesticides) for additional information.
- 5. Make sure that the "Net Contents" is clearly visible on the Front Panel of the can or clamshell labeling when presented in the marketplace.
