### Dear Ms. Griffin:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is in receipt of your application for notification under Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN) 98-10 for the above referenced product. The Biopesticides and Pollution Prevention Division (BPPD) has conducted a review of this request for its applicability under PRN 98-10 and finds that the action requested falls within the scope of PRN 98-10.

The labeling submitted with this application has been stamped "Notification" and will be placed in our records. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling with the modifications.

Although BPPD has determined that this action falls within the scope of PRN 98-10, we would like to also indicate that since EPA's authority for these product kits (pesticides packaged with non-pesticides) stops at the pesticide. EPA will not be offering any approval or disapproval on whether it is legal or proper to distribute a pocket knife (page 14 of label). You are responsible for ensuring that you are complying with any other federal laws and regulations that may govern the distribution of knives in commerce. BPPD also notes that your label contains a non-pesticide sublabel for an inert training canister (page 13 of label). The EPA has already reviewed this non-pesticide sublabel and deemed it acceptable in a previous label amendment action; however, this non-pesticide sublabel is not considered part of the stamped label (refer to EPA letter dated May 28, 2015 for further details).
