The revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) and amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, are acceptable, with the following term of approval:

1. You must submit Storage Stabilty and Corrosion Characteristics (OCSP 830.6317 and 830.6320, respectively) data for this formulation within 18 months from the date of this approval letter.

Furthermore, this approval does not affect any terms or conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing terms or conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the following acceptable CSF:

• Basic CSF dated 04/17/2018

Any CSFs other than those listed above are superseded/no longer valid.

Please be informed, the efficacy data supporting this revised formulation will likely not be in compliance with our forthcoming updated EPA/OPP Bear Spray Guidance. Specifically, the data included in MRID 47308201 does not estimate pungency in ASTA (American Spice Trade Association) pungency units. Pungency must be estimated in ASTA pungency units and then converted to SHU (Scoville Heat Units). ASTA units can be converted to SHU by multiplying their value by 15. Furthermore, the data in MRID 47308201 does not demonstrate that the product is effective at both 70 and 35 degrees Fahrenheit (the product was only tested at 70 degrees Fahrenheit). You will be

**required to submit updated efficacy studies at the time that all registrants are required to do so**. The Agency recommends that you keep this preliminary announcement in mind when performing any future efficacy testing and/or preparing any future amendments to this registration.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling before you release this product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR § 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 § CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to your company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
