Continuously agitate the tank mix to maintain suspension. Spray entire contents of mixture within the same day of mixing. AQ10 can lose viability when left in water over 12 hours.

AQ10 may be an effective resistance management tool when used in an IPM spray program with sulfur

- and sterol inhibitors for control of powdery mildew. It is important to use AQ10 in at least two sequential sprays 7-14 days apart. These sequential applications give AQ10 the opportunity to build up sufficient populations for the most effective long term control.
- Initial applications should begin as soon as susceptible host tissue emerges.
- Foliage and/or fruit should be sprayed thoroughly with sufficient water carrier to ensure complete coverage.
- Applications should be repeated at an interval sufficient to maintain disease control, depending upon plant growth, disease pressure and weather conditions.
- Applications should be done at a time selected to maximize the contact of AQ10 with free water on the vegetation either from dew or water carrier. Optimal AQ10 germination and parasitism occur under high humidity conditions.
- Apply only with ground equipment.
- Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.
