On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby Registered/Reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act.

A copy of the labeling accepted in connection with this Registration/Reregistration is returned herewith.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an indorsement or approval of this product by this Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data. Since there are presently no technical polybutene products registered with the Agency, one of the types of data that you will be responsible for would be the chemistry data (40 CFR 158.120) on your technical polybutene.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 55943-1."
- b. On the front panel change "REPELLANT" to "REPELLENT." Delete "s" from "Active Ingredients." After "CAUTION" add "See additional precautionary statements on back panel."

- c. The registrant's name and address must appear on the label. We would suggest that you move ICCI's name and address to the right and place your name and address to the left, as follows:

- d. The EPA Establishment Number must appear on the label or packaging.
- e. On the back panel change "REPELLANT" to "REPELLENT." Also, change "turps" to "turpentine."
- f. The metric system may be used on the label, if preceded by the English system. For example, "1/5-1/3 inch" should precede "5-8 mm."
- g. Add the word "Building" before "Surfaces."
- h. Revise "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" as follows:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Environmental Hazards

Do not apply to surfaces where small protected bird species may become entrapped by this tacky repellent.

Chemical Hazard

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

- i. The correct "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" format is as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store . . . below.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes . . . facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not . . . trash.

- j. Delete references to "HOT FOOT SEALER" unless this specific sealer is readily available in this country.

k. The efficacy test results are consistent with the claims made for the product. The data reported did not address duration of effect beyond 3 days. Therefore, if you wish claims for longer duration, you will have to submit additional efficacy data.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

4. Within 15 months of this Notice of Registration, submit storage stability data [1 year, 4 samples, 40 CFR 158.120(63.17)]. See Registration Guidelines for details (ordering information enclosed).

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

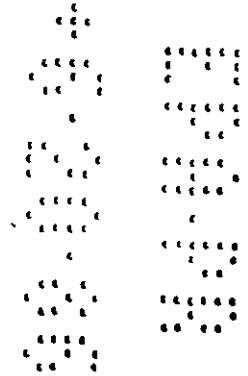

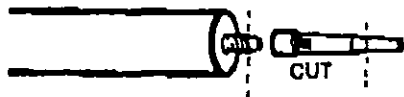
✓ SURFACES TO BE TREATED: HOT FOOT SHOULD BE APPLIED TO ALL LANDING AND ROOSTING AREAS, E.G., TOP EDGE OF GIRDERS, BEAMS, LEDGES, GUTTERS, ETC.

✓ TYPE OF BIRDS: PIGEONS

✓ CRITICAL COMMENTS. APPLY IN STRIPS 5-8MM THICK AND RUN IN A WORM-LIKE PATH AS DESCRIBED BELOW. FOR WIDE SURFACES IT MAY BE NECESSARY TO REPEAT AT 10CM INTERVALS.



✓ GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS. SURFACES TO BE TREATED SHOULD BE DRY AND CLEANED TO REMOVE DROPPINGS, DUST, ETC. ON POROUS SURFACES A SEALER SUCH AS HOT FOOT SEALANT SHOULD BE APPLIED BEFORE USING HOT FOOT. DO NOT APPLY IN WET, DAMP, OR FREEZING CONDITIONS.
