- 4. As indicated in our January 21, 1987 letter, submit for our files the following for "Crystal Coat":
 - a. Labeling, and
 - b. Confidential Statement of Formula.
- 5. The word "BRAND" must be in the same type size as "BAIT."

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

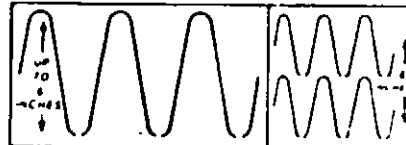

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product
in a manner inconsistent with this label.

- Surfaces to be treated: Hot Foot should be applied to all landing and roosting areas, e.g., top edge of girders, beams, ledges, gutters, etc.
- Type of birds: Pigeons
- Critical comments: Apply in strips ½" thick and run in a worm-like path as described below. For wide surfaces it may be necessary to repeat at 6 inch intervals.



- General Instructions: Building surfaces to be treated should be dry and cleaned to remove droppings, dust, etc. On porous surfaces a sealer such as Crystal Coat should be applied before using Hot Foot. Do not apply in wet, damp, or freezing conditions. HFI recommends that a coating of Crystal Coat be applied to all Hot Foot applications to protect against discoloration by dust and dirt and minimize the contact of birds' feathers with gel.



- Removal: Any organic solvent such as kerosene and mineral turpentine will remove Hot Foot.
- Precautionary Statements —

Dermal Hazard: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. If on skin or in eyes flush with plenty of water. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.

Environmental Hazards: Do not apply to surfaces where small protected bird species may become entrapped by this tacky repellent. Do not apply on surfaces where people walk or stand.

Chemical Hazard: Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

- Storage:** Store in an area inaccessible to children and pets. Do not store near food or feed. Do not store in an environment which will corrode the plastic cartridge. Any leaking cartridge should be disposed of as directed below.
- Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
- Container Disposal:** Do not re-use container. Securely wrap original cartridge in several layers of paper and dispose of in trash.
