The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted. A copy of your proposed labeling stamped "ACCEPTED WITH COMMENTS" is enclosed.

WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted the labeling changes that are necessary to comply with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K, described in PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11. Any other labeling changes submitted in connection with this amendment application but not directly related to compliance with the WPS have not been reviewed or accepted by the Agency. If you wish to make such changes, you must submit a separate amendment application proposing them. 

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. In case of contact, wash skin with soap and water; for eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes and get medical attention.

Personal Protective Equipment:

Some materials that are chemical-resistant to this product are listed below. If you want more options, follow the instructions for category C on an EPA chemical resistance category section chart.

Applicators and other handlers must wear:

- Long-sleeved shirt and long pants
- Chemical-resistant gloves, such as barrier laminate or butyl rubber or nitrile rubber or neoprene rubber or polyvinyl chloride (PVC) or viton

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE), and restricted-entry interval. The requirements in this box only apply to uses of this product that are covered by the Worker Protection Standard.

Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 24 hours.

PPE required for early entry to treated areas that is permitted under the Worker Protection Standard and that involves contact with anything that has been treated, such as plants, soil, or water is:

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BANVEL CST is a specially formulated product for controlling undesirable trees and their sprouts in forest and non-cropland areas, such as along fence rows, drainage ditchbanks and rights-of-way. This product requires no dilution or mixing and can be applied directly to freshly cut surfaces of trees such as:

Ailanthus	Hickory
Alder	Hornbeam
Ash	Maple
Aspen	Oak
Basswood	Persimmon
Birch	Poplar
Cedar	Sassafras
Cherry	Serviceberry
Cottonwood	Sourwood
Dogwood	Sumac
Elm	Sweetbay
Fir	Sycamore

IMPORTANT

Do not contaminate irrigation ditches or water used for domestic purposes.

Do not apply to areas where the possible downward movement into the soil or surface washing may cause contact of BANVEL CST with the roots of desirable plants. Desirable plants, such as trees and shrubs, may also be affected by root uptake of herbicide from excretion by the roots of nearby treated trees. Therefore, do not use BANVEL CST close to desirable plants unless possible injury can be tolerated.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

FRILL OR GIRDLE TREATMENTS:

Make a continuous cut or a series of overlapping cuts using an axe to girdle tree trunk. Spray or paint cut surface with the BANVEL CST.

STUMP TREATMENTS:

Spray or paint freshly cut surface with the BANVEL CST. The area adjacent to the bark should be thoroughly wet.

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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE

Store in original container in a well-ventilated area separately from fertilizer, feed and foodstuffs. Avoid cross-contamination with other pesticides. Spillage or leakage should be contained and absorbed with clay granules, sawdust, or equivalent material for disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Triple rinse pesticide from containers and use rinsates in the pesticide application. Wastes which cannot be used according to label instructions may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
