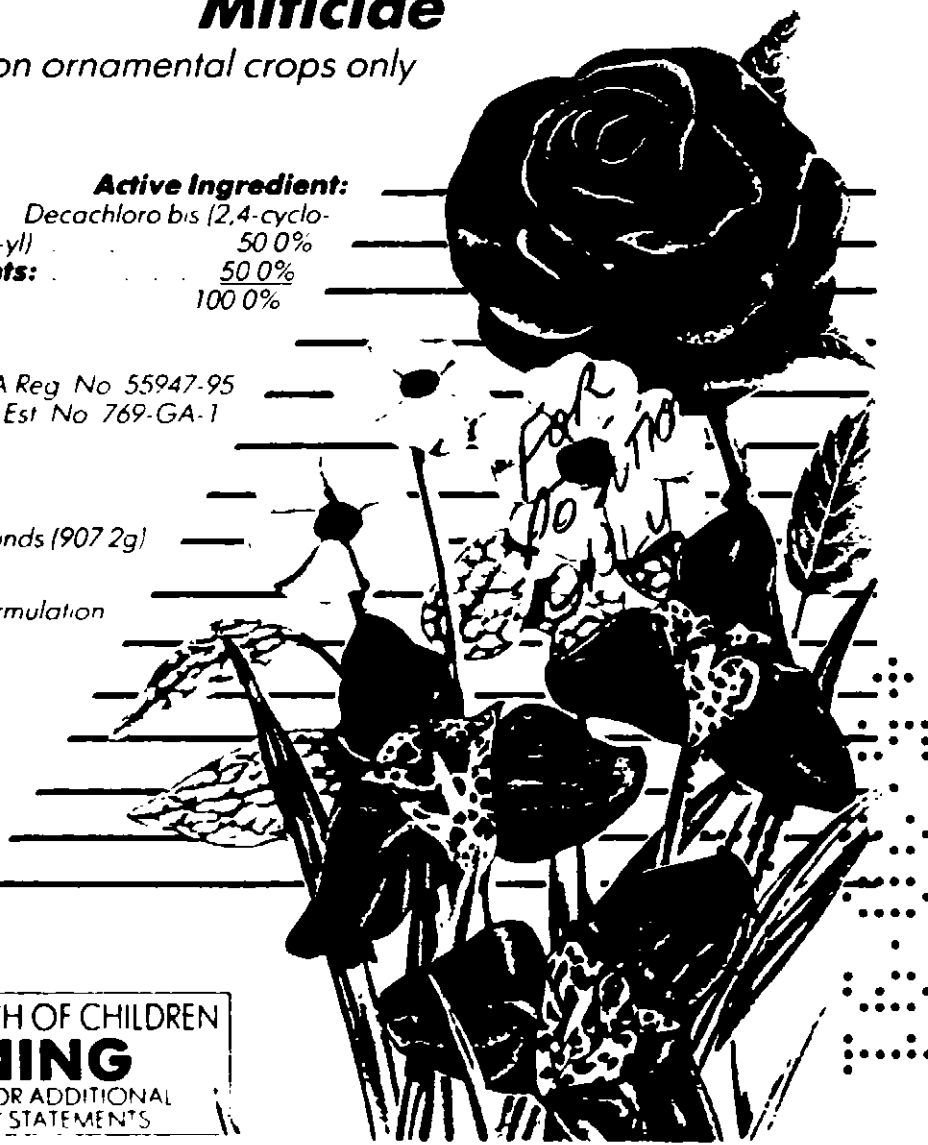

Hazards To Humans

Warning

Recommended Applications

PENTAC® WP is a specific miticide that is very effective against phytophagous mites such as Two-Spotted, European Red, Tumid Spider and Broad mites. It is recommended for use on ornamental plants, such as those listed below, grown in greenhouses, shadehouses and certain outdoor situations. Check with your local State Agricultural Extension Service Agent for recommended frequency of application in your area.

PENTAC WP has a long residual activity.

PENTAC WP is recommended for use on most ornamental plants including those listed below.

Interior and Plantscape Use

Apply PENTAC WP at a rate of 8 ounces (by weight) per 100 gallons of water. For smaller quantities, mix PENTAC WP at the rate of one level teaspoon per gallon of water. Mix well before spraying. It is important to assure complete coverage by spraying foliage to point of run-off, thoroughly wetting upper and lower leaf surfaces.

Outdoor Use

Apply PENTAC WP at a rate of 12 to 16 ounces (by weight) per 100 gallons of water, thoroughly covering foliage to point of runoff. Use of drop nozzles angled to direct spray upwards under leaves is recommended to assure complete coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces.

Greenhouse and Shadehouse Use

Apply PENTAC WP at a rate of 8 ounces (by weight) per 100 gallons of water. For smaller quantities, mix PENTAC WP at the rate of one level teaspoon per gallon of water.

Flowering Plants: Roses, Miniature Roses, Chrysanthemum, Camellia, Gardenia, Poinsettia, Snapdragon, Zinnia and Delphinium.

Tropical Foliage Plants: Palms, Maranta, Zebra Plant, Schefflera, Dieffenbachia and Aphelandra.

Other Commercial Ornamental Plants:

Arbovitae, Hemlock, Spruce, Birch, Dogwood, Azalea, Taxus (Yew), Succulents and Evergreen trees.
