**TANK MIX TREATMENTS IN CORN**

TOUGH 3.75 EC is recommended to be used sequentially and/or tank mixed with other herbicides as part of a complete weed control program. TOUGH 3.75 EC is a contact herbicide and must be applied to emerged actively growing weeds. For a listing of weeds controlled, refer to the TOUGH 3.75 EC Directions for Use Booklet. If weeds are under stress and not actively growing, they will be more difficult to control.

**Tank Mix Treatments**

TOUGH 3.75 EC may be tank mixed for control of additional weeds. Read and follow the label of each tank mix product used for precautionary statements, directions for use, rates and timings, and other restrictions.

**TOUGH 3.75 EC plus Sencor® (metribuzin):** For additional broadleaf weed control, apply 1 to 2 pints of TOUGH 3.75 EC with 1 to 2 ounces of Sencor® DF (or the equivalent 4L) per treated acre.

Occasional leaf burn may occur. The burn is similar to that seen with fluid fertilizer. Crop recovery is generally rapid with no lasting effects. To reduce the potential for crop injury, applications should be made to dry foliage when weather conditions are not extreme. Directed applications with drop nozzles are recommended to reduce the potential for injury and improve coverage of weed foliage.
