Dear Dr. Bryant,

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following labeling change before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

In the first sentence in the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" section change "organisms" to "organisms".

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A note about the subject labeling is that the "CONDITIONS OF SALE AND WARRANTY" section repeatedly refers to "Agrolinz, Inc.", even though you now own the product. Do you really mean to retain Agrolinz in this section?

The amended Confidential Statement of Formula was reviewed by the Product Chemistry Review Section and found to be acceptable. It has been placed in the file for the subject product.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

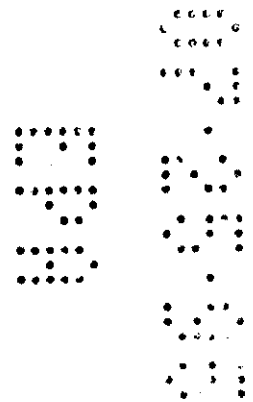
