

- Insert screwdriver into slot in orange lock ring and twist, snapping lock ring in two.
- 3. Remove both parts of separated lock ring.
- 4. Turn arrow on activator switch to OFF position.
- 5. Push activator switch securely down against top of sprayer. This will pierce the safety seal inside the dispenser.
- 6. To begin spraying, turn on water and then move activator switch to the \underline{ON} position.
- 7. Apply uniformly over 2,500 square feet.
