- c. Add a hazard statement to the label that reads "Irritant to eyes. Avoid contact with eyes. If contact occurs, flush eyes with plenty of water. When done, call your physician." When done, you will revise the label to read as follows:

*Contains xylene range aromatic solvent.

d. Please note that the signal word and child hazard warning must be 18-point and 12-point type size, accordingly.

e. We would prefer that the Statement of Practical Treatment (SOPT) section be located on the front panel.

f. The "If Swallowed etc." begins, for each exposure route should be italicized as in upper copy.

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

If in eyes - Hold eyelids apart, flush with plenty of water, and get medical attention.

If on skin - Wash thoroughly with plenty of soap and water. Remove and clean contaminated clothing. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.

Pesticide Disposal: Securely wrap original container including any unused product in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

j. Under general information revise the following to read ". . . insect pests in lawns (as listed in the Directions For Use)."

3. Please provide the upper and lower certified limits based on pure active ingredients rather than the technical or concentrate. ~~The~~ lower limit of the active, including any solvent declared as active, must not fall below the label claim.

4. You must submit a 1-year storage stability study on this formulated product. You will have 14 months from the date of this registration to submit such results or this product will be subject to cancellation.

5. We note the revised product name and the product are registered accordingly.

6. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Immediately start the procedures given below. If further treatment is needed, contact a Poison Center, a Physician, or the nearest hospital. For additional medical or toxicological information, call collect, day or night, Stauffer Emergency Medical Assistance, (203) 226-6602.

If swallowed, immediately give several glasses of water but do not induce vomiting. This product contains a xylene range hydrocarbon solvent. Contact a physician immediately.

If in eyes, hold eyelids apart, flush with large amounts of running water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention.

If on skin, wash thoroughly with plenty of soap and water. Remove and clean contaminated clothing.

If inhaled, remove to fresh air get medical attention if respiratory irritation occurs.

Note to Medical Personnel: This product contains a petroleum solvent and also is a cholinesterase inhibitor. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition occurs, atropine by injection is antidotal. Pralidoxime chloride (2-PAM) is also antidotal but only when given in conjunction with atropine.

SPECIAL DELIVERY™ Spray On Liquid Lawn Insecticide II is an emulsifiable solution which, when diluted with water from a garden hose, is intended for the control of certain insect pests in lawns.

In the directions for use which follow, best control is obtained when application is made at the first sign of insect infestation. Application should be repeated as necessary to maintain control.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IMPORTANT: Read the entire Directions for Use before using this product.

WHERE TO USE:

For Use On Lawns. Thoroughly wet down lawn several hours before applying.

Pests:

For Control of: Ants, Armyworms, Bermudagrass Thrips, Crickets, Cutworms, Earwigs, Lawn Billbugs*, Chinch Bugs, Sod webworms (Lawn moths), Leafhoppers, Mites (Bermudagrass, Clover), Sowbugs (Pillbugs), Springtails, White grubs**.

- * Lawn Billbugs: Apply when insect activity is first observed or when lawn is chewed or brown grass is present indicating damage from the insect.
- ** White grubs of Japanese beetle, European Chafer, and Southern Chafer: Make application any time between late July and early October. Wet lawn thoroughly after application.

HOW TO USE:

Shake well before using.

1. Attach spray nozzle to garden hose. Turn nozzle clockwise to firmly attach it to hose.
2. Remove child resistant cap from bottle (directions on cap) and screw bottle into spray nozzle.
3. Turn the on/off switch on top of the spray nozzle counter clockwise to the "OFF" position. Then turn on water at the faucet.
4. To begin spraying, turn the sprayer nozzle switch clockwise to the "ON" position. The water automatically mixes with the product. Walk at a steady pace spraying in a side to side arc, slightly overlapping treated areas and covering 2000 sq. ft. from this package. Refer to graduated scale on side of container to guide coverage.
5. To stop spraying, turn the sprayer nozzle switch counter clockwise to the "OFF" position and turn off water at the faucet.
