FIRST AID

If Swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.

Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact

Advise the medical personnel that the product contacted is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Be sure to describe the type and extent of exposure and the patient's symptoms.
