If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rise skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT - First Aid

*Under the Federal Insecticide,
Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act,
as amended, for the pesticide
registered under EPA Reg. No.
56077-70*

Call a Poison Control Center or a physician immediately.

If an exposure occurs or is suspected, immediately initiate the following procedures. If further treatment is needed, contact a Poison Control Center or medical staff. Provide accurate information on the patient's symptoms, extent and time of exposure.

If Swallowed: Provided the patient is conscious induce vomiting immediately by drinking 2 glasses of water and touching back of throat with finger or as directed by medical personnel. If vomiting occurs give water again. Avoid inhalation of vomitus by leaning forward with head down. Get medical attention immediately. Show the container, label or Data Sheet.

If on Skin: Wash contaminated areas thoroughly with soap and water. Do not reuse contaminated clothes or foot ware until washed or thoroughly cleaned. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If in Eyes: Flush with copious amounts of clean water for 10 - 15 minutes. Irrigate with eyewash solution or clean water, holding eyelids apart, for at least 15 minutes. Remove any contact lenses and continue flushing for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention, if irritation persists.

If Inhaled: Remove individual to fresh air. Seek medical attention if breathing difficulty develops.

Medical Information: If cholinesterase inhibition is suspected, atropine by injection is antidotal. Do not administer pralidoxime chloride (2-PAM) as an antidote. Advise the medical personnel that the product contacted is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Be sure to describe the type and extent of exposure and the patient's symptoms.
