For pools having just visible algae growth, add 10 fluid ounces of ALGAE GONE CONCENTRATE per 10,000 gallons of water. For pools with heavy algae growth, remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For pools with heavy algae growth, add initially 6 to 11 fluid ounces of ALGAE GONE CONCENTRATE per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of ALGAE GONE CONCENTRATE should be made 10,000 gallons of water 10 days after initial treatment for maintenance.
