

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label directions. ALGAE GONE PLUS is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tubs that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness pool owners should remove decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae before using ALGAE GONE PLUS.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of ALGAE GONE PLUS per 10,000 gallons of water. Remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of pools with heavy algae growth add initially 20 to 37 fluid ounces of ALGAE GONE PLUS per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 7 fluid ounces of ALGAE GONE PLUS per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and hot tubs with algae growth require an initial dose of 4 fluid ounces of ALGAE GONE PLUS per 1000 gallons of water. After cleaning spa, whirlpool, hot tub, decorative fountain, or hot tub, add 4 fluid ounces of ALGAE GONE PLUS per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 fluid ounce of ALGAE GONE PLUS should be made every 7 days for maintenance.

ALGAE GONE PLUS will prevent algae growth during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. Pools that are only treated during the swimming season and are free of algae should add 32 fluid ounces of algicide per 10,000 gallons of water. If season pools have some visible algae growth, add 37 fluid ounces of ALGAE GONE PLUS per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. If necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times during the season.

ALGAE GONE PLUS is compatible with other pool chemicals used to treat pools and spas and is effective at all temperatures. ALGAE GONE PLUS can be used in conjunction with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine needed. However, do not mix ALGAE GONE PLUS with other chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children.
