**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**  
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:** If Swallowed, do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard. Get medical attention. If on Skin, wash off with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If in Eyes, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, serving or storage areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**For Control of Wasps and Hornets:** Hold container in upright position to spray. Stand safe distance, 6-12 feet from nest and not directly underneath. Aim valve opening at nest with wind at your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly wet. Hit wasp and hornets at nest where possible. Best time to spray is in early morning or in evening if wasps and hornets congregate nest at night. If you want to remove nest wait at least 24 hours. Do not apply to pets or contaminate food, foodstuffs, dishes or utensils. Avoid spraying plants foliage as injury may occur. For outdoor use only. Not a space spray.
