Dear Ms. Mann:

The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

- Two alternate formulation names Cedar Tone Gold (formulation 3); and Cedar Tone Brown (formulation 4) which are identified on the product label
- Two alternate Confidential Statements of Formula (CSFs) for Cedar Tone Gold (formulation 3); and Cedar Tone Brown (formulation 4), both dated 1/21/2010

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

- 1. On page 1 in the ingredients section, change the word "INERT" to "OTHER".
- 2. On page 2 under the Directions for Use; second sentence of the second paragraph: change the word "should" to "must" so as to be compliant with PR Notice 2000-5.
- 3. On page 2, move the Environmental Hazards language below the PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS language.
- 4. On page 2, delete the third paragraph under the Precautionary Statements section (beginning with "DANGER: This product may cause.....") as this language already appears elsewhere.
- 5. On page 2, change the USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS heading to USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS.
- 6. On page 2 in the USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS box, change "should" to "must".
- 7. Per PR Notice 2001-1, update the FIRST AID statement for "If Swallowed" to read:
- Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor.
- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

General Comments

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

The new alternate CSFs, dated 1/21/2010, are acceptable. Copies of the CSFs have been inserted in your file for future reference.

X-100 Natural Seal* Wood Preservative is designed to penetrate the wood, protecting against cracking, splitting, cupping, curling, sap stain, mold and mildew and against the environmental forces of wind, rain, snow, ice and sun. X-100 Natural Seal* Wood Preservative is E.P.A. registered.

X-100 Natural Seal* Wood Preservative is for use on all wood surfaces susceptible to moisture damage including cedar, redwood, pine, plywood, T1-11, cypress, fir, dimensional lumber, siding, decking, logs and roofs. X-100 Natural Seal* Wood Preservative is available in transparent and semi-transparent stains.

PROPER SURFACE PREPARATION

To achieve the maximum effectiveness of this product the surface must be cleaned of dirt, mildew, loose wood fibers, chalky residue, foreign matter and must be dry.

Surface must be dry. Remove mill glaze/shiny lumber, tannic acid bleed, rust stains from fasteners, weathered grey and dirty wood with X-180 Weathered Wood Restorer*

EXISTING COATING (other than X-100 finishes)

Strip the existing finish with **Super Blo StripTM** or other, appropriate ABRP, Inc coatings remover. *NOTE*: Before beginning removal process test to determine removal product suitability, dwell time and dilution ratio if applicable. After stripping is completed, clean with **X-180 Weathered Wood Restorer**. Failure to remove the existing coating will cause unsatisfactory finish results. Removal of the existing coating by methods other than what is specified may produce unsatisfactory finish results.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Mix X-100 Natural Seal* Wood Preservative well before using. A test area should be performed before beginning overall project to determine the amount of X-100 Natural Seal* Wood Preservative the wood will absorb, dry time, wood porosity and total desired look.

Fully protect all adjacent surfaces, as well as, general work area. When spraying near vegetation, cover plant life with cardboard or other suitable material in case of overspray.

FOR BEST RESULTS AND OPTIMAL PENETRATION: APPLY TO DRY WOOD. DO NOT APPLY IF RAIN IS IMMINENTLY FORECASTED. BOTH SURFACE AND AIR TEMPERATURE MUST BE ABOVE 50°F.

APPLICATION

- 1. Apply X-100 Natural Seal* Wood Preservative with a brush, or low pressure pump sprayer. Always back brush into surface to ensure uniform coverage.
- Apply as much X-100 Natural Seal* Wood Preservative as the wood will absorb.
- 3. Keep a wet edge to avoid lap marks.
- 4. If the wood can absorb more X-100 Natural Seal® Wood Preservative and extra protection or more depth of color is desired, apply an additional coat of X-100 Natural Seal® Wood Preservative at a later date.

Note: If after a 12 hour period the surface remains oily, over application has occurred. To remove excess product use **ABR® Deck & Siding Wash**.

MAINTENANCE

This product will not protect your deck from getting dirty. Routine maintenance cleaning is required to keep up the appearance of your deck. Maintain the surface treated with X-100 Natural Seaf* with ABR* Deck & Slding Wash or X-180 Weathered Wood Restorer".

MILDEW

This product contains agents that will inhibit mold and mildew growth.

COVERAGE

Sidewalls-Smooth or rough sawn lumber including logs, first coat 100 sq. ft. per gallon. Second coat 200 sq. ft. per gallon.

Roofs-75 to 150 sq. ft. per gallon, depending on porosity of surface.

DRY TIME: Allow at least 24 hours to dry.

VOC CONTENT LIMIT: 350 g/L (2.89 lbs/gal) or less
