PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND ANIMALS

CAUTION:

Harmful if swallowed, ~~absorbed through skin or inhaled~~ Avoid contact with ~~eyes, skin or clothing~~. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

This spray is intended for external use on dogs (cats) only and is not to be taken internally by man or animal. Not intended for use on humans. Do not allow children to handle or play with this product. Do not bring into contact with food, cooking utensils or food preparation surfaces.

Some animals and humans may be sensitive to this spray. Discontinue use at first sign of irritation or adverse reaction. Do not use on sick or convalescing animals.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Do not induce vomiting. CALL A PHYSICIAN OR POISON CONTROL CENTER IMMEDIATELY.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists

IF IN EYES: Flush with water immediately. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

This product contains petroleum distillates, as solvents, inducing vomiting may cause asperation resulting in chemical pneumonitis.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this spray in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To operate, remove protective cap from top of can. To treat pets, cover animal's eyes with hand and hold container approximately 8 inches from animal. Point opening on side of valve in desired direction for spray. To release spray, place finger on top of valve and push down. Slightly dampen hair and skin on head, ears and chest. Rub into place around mouth, nose and eyes with fingertips. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing with legs last. For best penetration on long-haired pets, rub hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat treatment as needed.

Do not use on nursing bitches (dams) or puppies (kittens) under six weeks of age.

Do not use on wet carpets. Before using test small area of carpet for colorfastness.

To treat carpets, hold can 12 inches from carpet and spray lightly, making sure to reach all cracks and crevices. Repeat as necessary. May be used on pet's bedding. For best results, bedding should be sprayed and then replaced with fresh bedding.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in a cool place away from heat or sunlight. Do not reuse empty container, replace cap and discard in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture.
